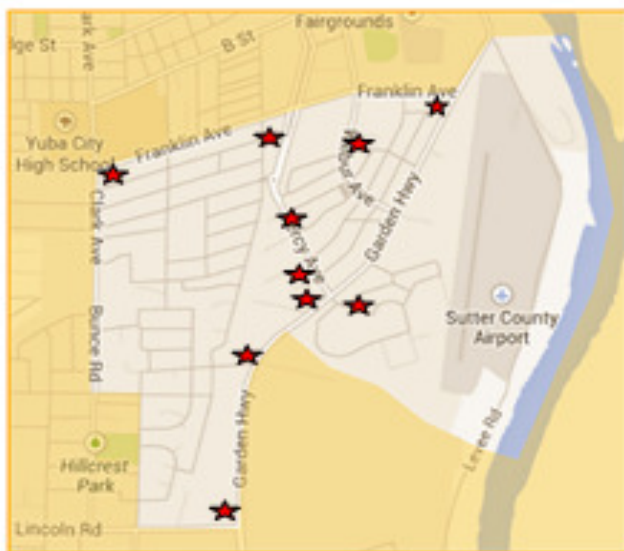


## Where you live shouldn't determine how long you live.....but it does

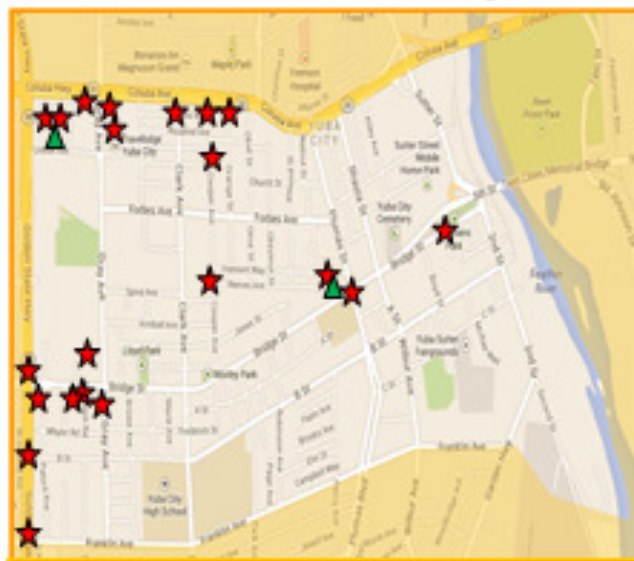

### Central Garden Highway



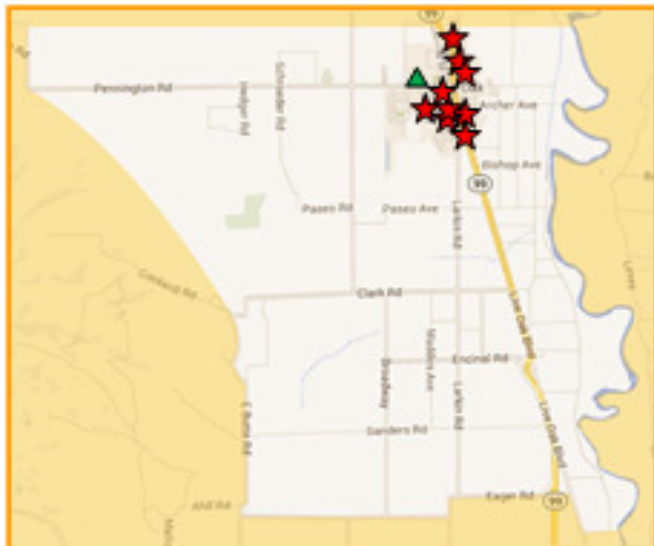

### Downtown Yuba City



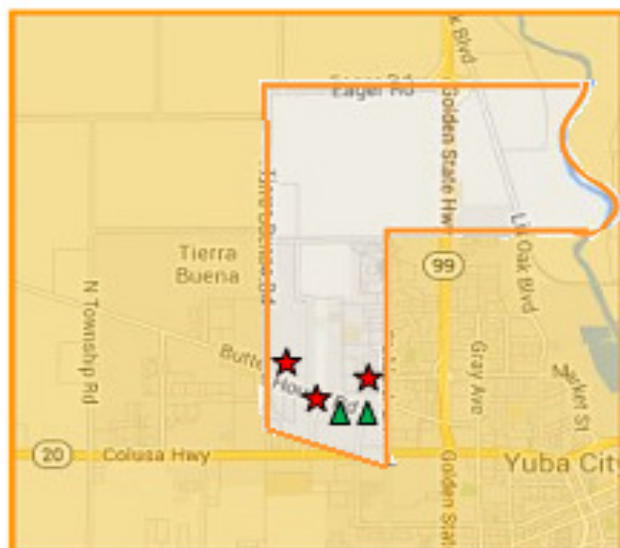
**7,262** population
