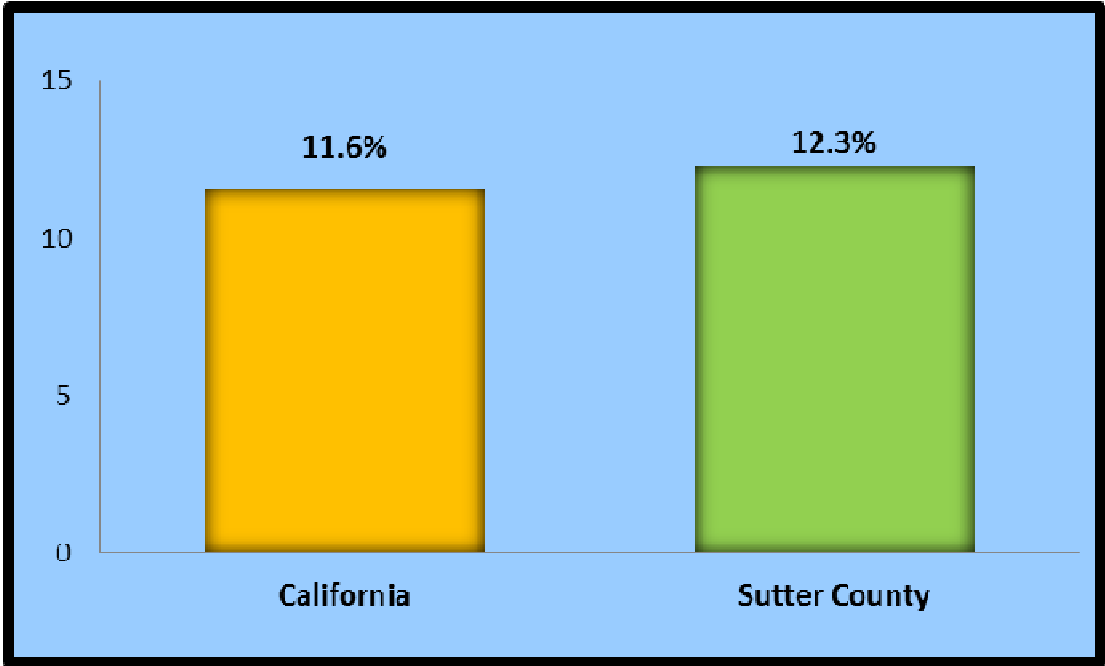




# Sutter County- Tobacco

### Adult Smoking Rates - Sutter County

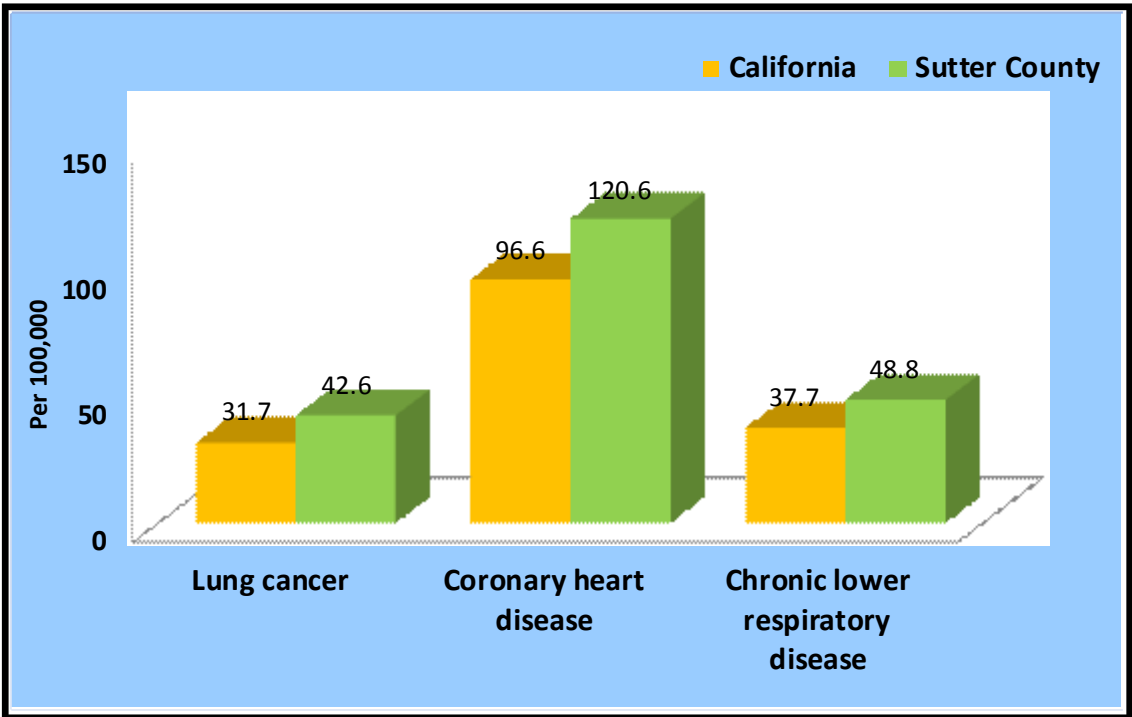


In 2014, 12.3% of Sutter County residents were current smokers, compared to the state rate of 11.6%.<sup>1</sup>

### Tobacco Related Deaths - Sutter County

The average coronary heart disease death rate in Sutter County for 2012-2014 was 120.6 per 100,000 persons compared to the state rate of 96.6.<sup>2</sup>

The average lung cancer death rate in Sutter County is 42.6 per 100,000 persons compared to the state rate of 31.7.<sup>2</sup>

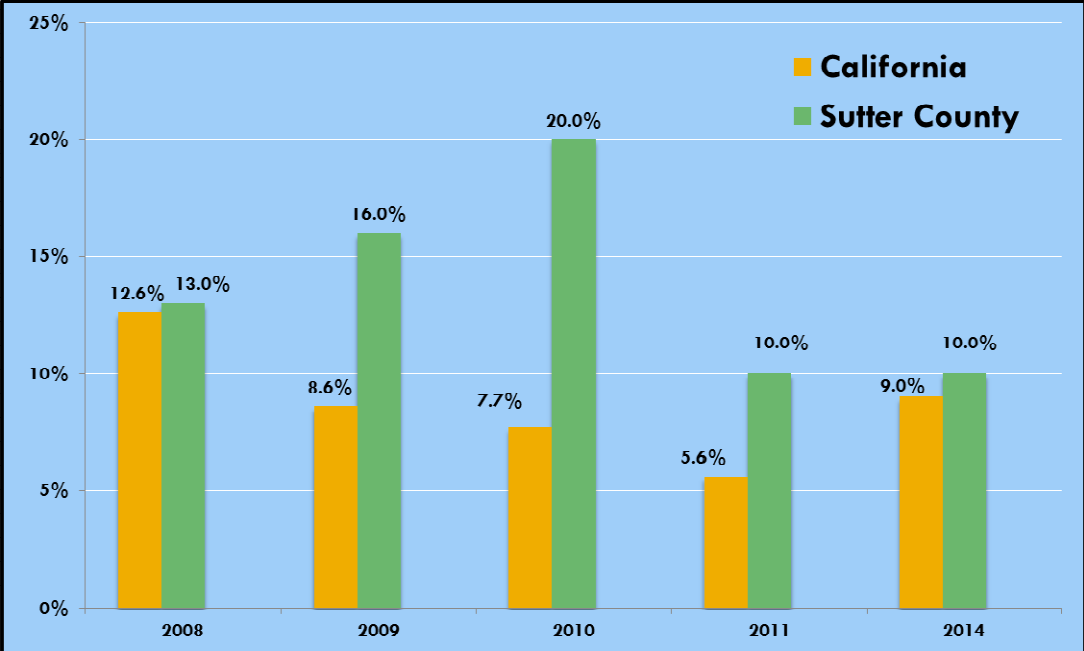


# Sutter County– Tobacco

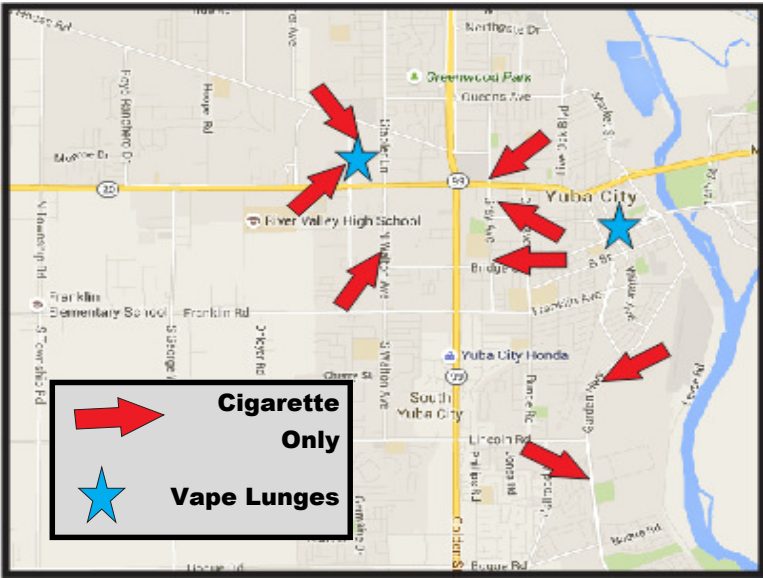
**10% of stores in Sutter County attempted to sell tobacco products to underage youth in 2014 <sup>3</sup>**

In a recent focus group of local high school age youth students were asked “where do you get your tobacco products?”— more than half of the students reported buying tobacco products at convenience stores and smoke shops. <sup>4</sup>



### Cigarette Only & Vape Stores

Nearly 9/10 adult smokers start before the age of 18. <sup>5</sup>



This map shows 10 “Cigarette Only” & “Vape” stores located within a 5 mile radius in Yuba City. These stores are in addition to the other **85 locations** where tobacco products are sold in Sutter County. <sup>6</sup>
