Yuba City Unified School District (YCUSD) is requesting the following line item transfers for the 2019-2020 Smart Start Program Budget (see attached budget detail & Smart Start School Readiness Distance Support proposal):

- \$33,000 from Certificated Salaries to Service & Other Operating Exp
- \$13,000 from Classified Salaries to Materials & Supplies

These line item transfers will allow us to facilitate the "2020 Smart Start School Readiness Distance Support" beginning in mid-July. In order to provide and support this program, we are also requesting an extension of the 2019-20 grant through July 30th, 2020 for the following amounts:

- \$14,500 for Certificated Salaries
- \$2,500 for Classified Salaries
- \$4,000 for Certificated and Classified Benefits
- \$28,521.79 for Materials & Supplies
- \$47,936.99 for Services & Other Operating Expenses
- \$5.500 for Indirect

These line item transfers and budget extension are not a request for additional funding and **do not** change the overall grant amount for the 2019-2020 school year. Please let me know if the Sutter County Children and Families Commission requires any additional information to approve these line item transfers and budget extension.

YCUSD - Summer 2020 Smart Start "School Readiness Distance Support" Plan

- 1. Smart Start clerk will connect (by phone) with parents who have registered their children for Junior Kindergarten or Kindergarten:
 - i. Preschool experience
 - ii. Interest in receiving "School Readiness" kit via mail
 - iii. Interest in two contacts by phone (in mid & late July) for school readiness suggestions & opportunity to ask questions about JK/Kindergarten
 - iv. Verify home address (for mailing) & best phone number
 - v. Confirm child's school site for JK/Kindergarten
- 2. Order School Readiness Kits from Scholastic
 - i. Kits will be sent directly to children's homes
 - ii. Order kits for each teacher who will be reaching out to parents by phone
- 3. Teachers will connect with each family assigned to them twice (via Google Voice or Google Meet):
 - i. Once in mid-July & once in late July
 - ii. Teacher will suggest skills practice/home activities to support school readiness
 - iii. Teacher will answer parents' questions about JK/Kindergarten
 - iv. Teacher will keep daily log of phone conversations

Ready4K Trauma Informed

- \$32,995 per year plus a one-time setup fee of \$3,495

Tier 3 (three year commitment)

50% of year one setup and licensing fees: Grant pays \$18,245; You pay \$18,245

40% of year two licensing fees: Grant pays \$13,198; You pay \$19,797

30% of year three licensing fees: \$9,898.50; You pay \$23,096.50

* If you prepay all three years of your portion we offer a 15% discount on your portion: $$18,245 + $19,797 + $23,096.50 = $43,320.50 \times 15\%$ discount =\$6,498 =Your pay \$36,822.50
