PROGRAM FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS

RECOMMENDATION: It is the recommendation of the Executive Director that the Commission approve funding \$25,000.00 for the Community and Childcare Provider Mini Grants as submitted.

BACKGROUND: Sutter County Children & Families Commission has invested over \$700,000 in mini grants for community projects and childcare providers since 2001. These mini grant funds have provided a wide variety of services and opportunities for Sutter County children and families including book giveaways, child care provider materials, computers, literacy activities, shot registry services, educational workshops, school readiness activities, provider education classes, community outreach and education projects, library improvement projects and community events. The Commission is committed to supporting the efforts of community projects and childcare providers to improve the lives of children and their families in Sutter County.

In June 2019 the Commission approved the release of \$25,000 in funding for mini grants. The mini grant application was released, and 10 community applications and 12 childcare provider applications were received by the application deadline. All applicants attended the mandatory application workshop and were provided with technical assistance to complete their applications. All applications received by the deadline were reviewed. The total funding requests for the 10 community mini grant applicants are \$35,271.78 and the total funding requests for the 12 childcare provider mini grant applicants are \$15,488.54.

<u>CURRENT PROPOSAL:</u> Based on the scores of the childcare mini grant review committee, the Executive Director proposes to fund the following childcare mini grant applicants.
