

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Inclusive Group Care - In this PITC based workshop participants will gain an understanding of what inclusive group care is and looks like, and how it can have a positive impact on your classroom. If you desire to have a classroom community that includes ALL children, then this is the workshop for you!

You are the Foundation: Fostering Children's Social & Emotional Development- Reflect on what social-emotional development means to you and challenge yourself to re-frame your thoughts and beliefs to design a mindset that is most beneficial to fostering healthy social and emotional competence in children. This workshop will include many interactive activities for you to share your knowledge and experiences, and you will have the opportunity to practice re-framing frustrations into a more positive and constructive way.

Music in ECE: Fertilizer for Building a Better Brain - Come join Joe Moye in exploring how to support whole brain development. Using music in the classroom is creative, fun, and provides opportunities to improve language, math and classroom management.

Child Care Settings-Promoting Best Practices: Health and Safety First! - Children learn best when they are healthy and safe. Join staff from Public Health Infant Nutrition and Safety Programs for updates on best practices for child care providers. Topics include infant and child car seat safety updates, safe sleep recommendations including recalls for infant sleep devices, and information on breastfeeding and breastmilk storage and feeding.

Building Resilient Children— It is not easy growing up in today's world. With all that adults see and hear on television, print media and social media it seems necessary to build a world for children full of "don'ts", "duck and run" and "hide in place" experiences. In this uncertain world, can we teach our children to be safe when we are not there? Yes, we can! If trauma does occur, can we teach our children resiliency in a world that continually discounts their feelings and their voice? Yes, we can! Do we have partners in our essential efforts? Yes, we do!

Cuando Una Máscara Enmascara el Trauma - Los niños que han experimentado el trauma no expresan la angustia que sienten de una manera que es fácilmente reconocible y, en cambio, a menudo enmascaran su dolor con un comportamiento agresivo y desagradable. Como identificando los síntomas de trauma en nuestros hijos puede ayudarnos como educadores, proveedores y / o cuidadores a comprender y abordar mejor estos comportamientos confusos.

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Yoga and Mindfulness for Emotional Development— Participants in this session will experience yoga and mindfulness practices and learn engaging and fun ways to incorporate techniques and tools to help children manage their emotions through exciting activities. In addition, educators will explore the benefits and science behind why yoga and mindfulness strategies work. Be prepared for hands-on fun!

Engaging, Creative Circle Times and Small Groups Are you looking for fresh perspectives when planning
circle time and small groups? This workshop is your
opportunity to discover new ideas for engaging all
children during whole group and small group
activities. Participants will explore strategies and unique
materials, in addition to sharing their own success
stories. Come ready to join the fun!

Exploring Protective Urges - This PITC based session will introduce participants to protective urges. Families can have strong emotions when leaving their child in your care, and you can, too. As early educators we want the best for each child. It is important to be able to connect with families so that we also know their intentions. During this workshop, participants will explore a four step PITC-based reflective process: identifying feelings, discussing feelings with others, checking in with families, and developing action plans that can be immediately applied in your program.

The 4 Key Reasons for Challenging Behavior: Unlocking the Secret Code - Children and adults often become overstimulated, tired, and frustrated when involved in group care. What can we do to support positive caregiving relationships? When adults speak to children instead of speaking at them, get down on at the same level, and believe that children are emotionally capable we can more clearly see and identify the root cause of all behavior. Learn the 4 top reasons children's behavior doesn't match our expectations, and join other early care peers in practicing the strategies that address behavior and build children's self esteem and strengths.
