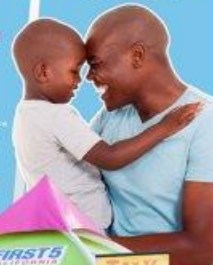

*The Nurtured Heart Approach* is an amazing set of strategies developed specifically for children with challenging behaviors. Often parents have tried many parenting techniques only to become discouraged when they do not work well. This approach works with children who have not responded well to traditional techniques, and will facilitate parenting success. Children whose parents learn to energize them are much more likely to do well in school, have healthy self-esteem, exhibit empathy and pro-social behavior, and avoid high-risk activities such as drug use, truancy, and criminal activity. Our objective is to see you have a positive influence on your kids and love it!
