

SUTTER COUNTY PHENOXY PERMIT CONDITIONS (April 1 through October 15) (Note **bold** crop addition in 2008.)

- 1. No aerial applications of phenoxy herbicides are permitted in Sutter County from April 1 through October 15.
- 2. No phenoxy herbicide applications shall be made to roadsides, ditch banks, field or row crops that are within two (2) miles of cotton or grapes.

-Orchard Strip Spraying - a registered approved phenoxy chemical may be applied up to 1/2 mile away from cotton or **grapes** provided there is a positive wind away from either crop for the duration of the application not exceeding 7 miles per hour.

- Ground applications within five (5) miles of cotton or grapes must be made with a positive 3. wind of at least two (2) miles per hour away from the cotton or grapes.
- 4. No ground applications shall be made when wind speed is in excess of 10 miles per hour.
- 5. Aerial applications within five (5) miles of cotton or grapes shall maintain a written log indicating air temperature, wind speed, and wind direction prior to beginning the application and to be recorded every tank refill or hourly whichever comes first for each day of application and to be made available for review by the Agricultural Commissioner's staff upon request.
- 6. A forty-eight hour Notice of Intent (NOI) is required.
- No ester formulation of phenoxy herbicides shall be applied from March 1 through 7. October 15 unless specifically authorized by the County Agricultural Commissioner.
- Only ground application equipment with nozzles delivering not less than 500 micron volume 8. median diameter (VMD) droplet size with 10 percent of the diameter by volume (Dv0.1) not less than 200 microns is permitted.
- 9. Ground application equipment for phenoxy applications shall be inspected by the Sutter County Department of Agriculture prior to the first application.
