IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 14077 OF THE CALIFORNIA FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL CODE (FAC) AND SECTION 6432, OF THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS (CCR), THE FOLLOWING, WHEN CHECKED (X), ARE PERMIT CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH WHEN APPLYING PESTICIDES LISTED ON RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMIT NUMBER:

- **1.** () Applicator is properly certified.
- 2. () Permittee not certified. Restricted material must only be applied by a Licensed Qualified Applicator.
- 3. () In accordance with Section 6434 (CCR), when the pesticide application is made by a PCO, the PCO is responsible to see that the Notice of Intent has been properly submitted.
- 4. () PCO must have a copy of Restricted Materials Permit & all applicable conditions (i.e. MAPS)
- 5. () Written recommendations shall be submitted to the Sutter County Ag Dept. upon request.
- 6. () Notice of Intent (NOI) shall be submitted 24 hours prior to the scheduled application. Please notify office if job is cancelled.
- 7. () Applicator shall consider, and if feasible, adopt any reasonable, effective and practice mitigation or use any feasible alternative which would substantially lessen any significant adverse impact on the environment or sensitive sites.
- 8. () The permittee shall comply with Section 6654 (CCR) which requires a 48-hour prior notification to beekeepers with bees located within one mile of the application site when applying pesticides harmful to bees, over "blooming plants", including cover crops.
- 9. () Dormant sprays containing both restricted and non-restricted materials injurious to bees cannot be applied after January 31st without authorization from the Agricultural Commissioner
- 10. () Applications shall be made only when school grounds are not occupied or when church is not in Session. Applications that are made within 1/4 mile to schools, churches, or dwellings shall be made with air movement away from them in order to prevent drift. The following fields locations have additional restrictions because of the potential hazards:
- 11. () Prior to employees being involved in pesticide applications, the permittee must have complied with Worker Safety regulations, as required by Section 6720 (CCR). In addition, all employees shall be trained for each chemical prior to use of that chemical.
