Process for formalizing official volunteers is time consuming. State regulations, lawsuit issues are potential hinderances. Public outreach when existing event was almost cancelled in the past. Liability for potential properties still the biggest issue.

 - a. Yuba City Boat ramp has power pole next to the dumpster. Boyds has a power pole +/-100 feet away (light pole). Idea has been turned down in the past possibly due to flood plain restriction or power. Mitigate permanent structure limitations by having the station on a trailer? Quote for heavy duty industrial started at \$70,000, ranged down to \$20,000 for lighter duty if self-build. Might get donations or school/restaurant surplus for the sink portion.
