

ORDINANCE NO. RIO RAMAZA CSD 2009-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RIO RAMAZA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
ESTABLISHING ADMINISTRATIVE FEES
FOR THE COMMUNITY OF RIO RAMAZA, CALIFORNIA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE RIO RAMAZA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE AND FINDINGS

The Board of Directors of the Rio Ramaza Community Services District finds that the public health and welfare make it necessary to establish administrative fees for those customers serviced by the District in the Community of Rio Ramaza, California. Equitable administrative fees will allow the District to continue providing services within the District's service areas, and will ensure that a cost-effective public service remains available to the residents.

SECTION 2: ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

Administrative fees shall be charged for special activities not associated with the normal provision of sewer services. Fees are based on anticipated costs to the District for services supplementary to normal services. Administrative fees shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

Description	Type	Special Fee
Payment Administrative Late Charge	Account	\$25
Interest on Unpaid Late Balance	Account	Maximum Legal Rate

SECTION 3: USE OF FEES REVENUES

Revenues generated by the district shall only be used to offset expenses of operating and maintaining the facility.

SECTION 4: AREAS OF APPLICATION

This ordinance shall apply only to those properties within the Community of Rio Ramaza, California served by the District.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY

If any portion of this ordinance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, that portion shall be considered a separate and independent provision, and the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect the following billing cycle after the date of final passage and, together with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against the ordinance, shall be published in the Appeal Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation, at least once before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of passage.

SECTION 7: SUPERSEDE

This ordinance supersedes all previously established administrative fees for the District.


