CHECKLIST



Application Specific Information

- Grower shall display at a central location for 30 days plus REI and before any fieldworkers enter treated fields.
- Application Specific Information shall include:
 - Site ID
 - Application date and time
 - Restricted Entry Interval
 - Product name, EPA #, and active ingredient
 - Adjuvant name and California Registration #
- Grower and Labor Contractor shall display a complete **A9** at the worksite or central location, when fieldworkers are in a treated field.
- A9** must describe the location of the Application Specific Information
- Description must be specific enough for fieldworkers to find and have unimpeded access to Application Specific Information

Employee Safety: Application

All employees must wear the following when making pesticide applications:

- Safety Glasses, side & brow protection
- Chemical Resistant Gloves
- Long Sleeved Shirt
- Long Pants
- Shoes and Socks

Danger / Warning chemicals require:

- Coveralls
- Closed Mixing / Loading system (Danger only)

- Triple-rinse empty pesticide containers
- Use an overhead water fill site or backflow preventer
- Read the label for specifics

Employee Safety: Respirator Use

- Voluntary Respirator Program
 - Voluntary Respirator Provision Information* sheet posted
- Required Respirator Programs occur when either the label or the employer requires a specific respirator. Examples of label required respirator use include:
 - Gramoxone
 - Diuron
 - Lorsban
 - Ziram
- Has the employee completed a Medical Evaluation Questionnaire?
- Has an annual Fit-Test for each type of respirator been completed and documented?

Employee Safety: Restricted Entry

- Read the *Agricultural Use Requirements* box on the pesticide label:
 - Restricted Use Interval (REI) in effect?
 - Early Entry Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) needed?
- No field work can be done in a field currently being treated or under REI; unless PPE provided
- Notify employees and operators within ¼ mile of application
- Post field if REI is longer than 7 days at all entry points or every 600'
- Is there a double notification required on the labels, i.e.: orally and posting field?

Field Worker Safety

- Complete and accurate A9 displayed on site
- State and Federal Boards are up to date and displayed
- Application Info displayed for past 30 Days
- MSDS sheets and Pesticide Use Records available
- Notify employees of any application within ¼ mile of worksite
- Soap, Water and Paper towels available
- Adequate drinking water available
- Adequate shade for employees
- Field worker training conducted and documented
