OFF-SITE KITCHENS THAT MAY BE USED BY TEMPORARY FOOD FACILITIES

- A. The following non-retail kitchens have annual food facility permits and Environmental Health Division approval to be used as off-site food preparation and storage facilities for temporary food facilities:
1. Non-profit sites
 - Yuba City Senior Center
7393 Lyon Street, Sutter
 - 777 Ainsley Avenue, Yuba City 822-4608
 - 9400 Larkin Road, Live Oak 695-3921
 2. Yuba City Area Schools
 - Andros Karperos Lincoln
 - April Lane Lincrest
 - Barry Park Avenue
 - Bridge Street Tierra Buena
 - Gray Avenue Yuba City High School
 - King Avenue
- B. Commercial food facilities that have an unrestricted annual food establishment permit.
- C. Commercial food facilities that have a restricted annual food facility permit may be used only within the restriction limitations.
- D. Other non-commercial kitchens might be allowed following Environmental Health Division inspection and approval.
- E. Comparable permitted food facilities in adjacent counties.

Permission from the proposed off-site food facility permittee would have to be obtained by the temporary food facility applicant. The operator of a temporary food facility would have to comply with California Uniform Retail Food Facilities Law in all respects, including proper transportation between the off-site kitchen and temporary food facility.
