




SMART Objective Example

- **Priority**: Reduce sexually transmitted diseases
- Overarching vision statement: Increase contact tracing/follow-up of sexual partners of confirmed cases
- Sample SMART objective:
 - By 2025 link 70% of STD contacts to treatment and testing services

Strategies:

- General approach or collection of actions to achieve a desired goal or overarching vision
- Provides a clear roadmap: smaller steps along the way to achieving an objective
 - Example: Improve and strengthen school-based sex education

Actions:

- Specific programmatic, policy or other action that implements or "operationalizes" the strategy
 - Example: Review and update current sex education curriculum to align with equitable, stigma-free, and evidence-based strategies
