NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is given that at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 21, 2024, in the City of Yuba City Council Chambers, 1201 Civic Center Boulevard, Yuba City, CA, the Sutter County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the following:

Project #U23-0003 (Kelly) – The project proposes to subdivide an existing 3.1± acre parcel within the Estate Residential (ER) district in the unincorporated county. The project proposal includes a Tentative Parcel Map to subdivide a 3.1± parcel into two (2) parcels sized 1.5± and 1.6± acres in the Estate Residential (ER) district; located at 786 Country Lane, on the south side of Country Lane and west side of Caminito Avenue, approximately 0.5 miles south of the city of Yuba City; APN: 23-120-060; Applicant/Owner: Matt Kelly (A Negative Declaration is proposed)

<u>Project #U23-0015 (Sutter County)</u> – Amendments to Article 25 of the Sutter County Zoning Code to incorporate updates regarding Permit Types and Findings in the unincorporated County (**This project is exempt from CEQA**)
