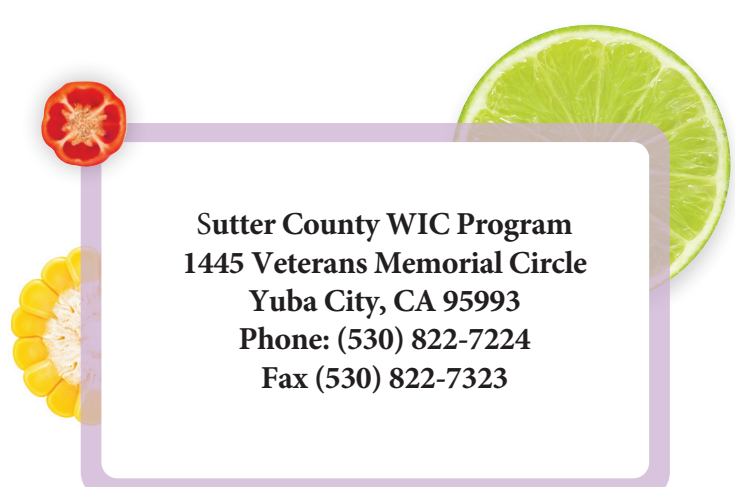
Women, Infants and Children (WIC) is a food and nutrition program for California families.
