

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS INUNDATED

Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain); average depths determined. For areas of alluvial fan flood-ing, velocities also determined. ZONE A99 To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base elevations determined.

Base Flood Elevation Line; Ele-

particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all planimetric features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Floodway widths are provided in the Flood Insurance Study Report. Coastal base flood elevations apply only landward of the shoreline.

Elevations reference marks are described in the Flood Insurance Study Report.
